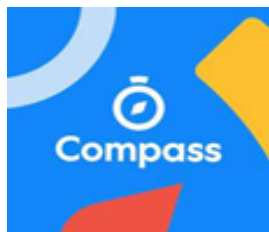
Refunds

By agreeing to pay by instalments, Compass will charge your credit card the following percentage.
